## Submission Guidelines

NewSouth, Inc., is an independent book publisher based in Montgomery, Alabama. We publish about 25 titles a year under three imprints: NewSouth Books (literature and poetry, history, biography and memoir, folklore and folk art); Junebug Books (young adult and children's fiction and non-fiction), and Court Street Press (fiction, poetry, and non-fiction). Our books are distributed and sold nationally.

We have a special interest in regional history, biography, autobiography, folklore, African-American, Native American, and civil rights subjects. We are primarily but not exclusively interested in Southern people and Southern settings. Our children's books often work to make understandable to young readers such complex subjects as slavery, segregation, the Civil War, the civil rights movement, and human rights. We accept and read both unsolicited and agented manuscripts.

Before submitting, we request that you obtain a catalog or visit our web site to become familiar with the types of books we publish. Address queries and manuscripts to Acquisitions Editor, P.O. Box 1588, Montgomery, AL 36102. Manuscripts should not be sent until requested. Please begin with a query, including a brief cover letter describing yourself, your work, and your goals, as well as a separate one- to two-page synopsis of the entire work, and why you believe we should publish it. It is often a good idea to find books published by NewSouth that you believe are in the same vein as yours.

Make sure that all your contact information is in the cover letter; email addresses are very much appreciated. You may include a self-addressed stamped postcard for acknowledgment that we have received the query letter or manuscript. If you do not have an email address, please include a self-addressed stamped letter envelope for correspondence.

When requested, manuscripts should be typed, double-spaced, and single-sided. Do not send diskettes. Please enclose copies of all items, including photos and illustrations—never originals. Do not send SASE or stamps for return of manuscripts or materials; new post office regulations prevent us from returning manuscripts, and we safely recycle what we cannot use.

Please try to refrain from calling to check on the status of your manuscript. NewSouth has no set reading period, instead looking to our incoming submissions when we have the availability or need for new works. Generally, we quickly reject submissions that obviously are not suitable for us, so if you have not received a response, it means the work is still under consideration.
